Annual Survey Feedback

Thank you to all our families who completed our annual survey. This feedback shapes the direction of the forum and helps us ensure training and work shops we put on meet the needs of our families.

We are feeding back on some of the key topics which parents and carers have reported to us.

Membership- Some parents and carers indicated that they were not sure if they were signed up to our membership. If you receive emails from us with links to training or asking you to complete surveys, you are a member.

Areas - There are still certain areas we are not engaging with parents and carers. This highlights to us we need to work on our marketing strategy and ensure parents and carers understand our role and the services we provide.

Key Patterns Emerging

- Autism is the single most frequently mentioned need (over 30 direct mentions).
- ADHD is the second most common, often co-occurring with ASD.
- Anxiety and emotional regulation appear in a large proportion of responses.
- Sensory needs are widespread, even when not formally diagnosed.
- Several families describe significant physical/medical needs, including wheelchair use, ataxia, epilepsy, and visual impairment.
- Many parents mention being on a pathway or awaiting assessment, showing high levels of unmet diagnostic need.
- A number of responses highlight social opportunities, transition support, and community access as unmet needs.

With autism being the highest area of need, some autism training or workshops will be sourced to support parents and carers as well as the wider family.

It was also highlighted that there is an issue with communication from schools to parents, and primary to secondary school. Lots of parents reported that their child is not getting support, the support is not consistent and there is a lack of understanding from teachers. All of this information will be feedback to the appropriate professionals for discussion.

Some parents and carers reported a disconnect with support from one service to another and this is something we will address in our marketing strategy.

One area highlighted by parents and carers was strategies to support children at home and understanding emotional regulation. We have already reached out to Inside Out to source some sessions about emotional regulation strategies for parents so will keep you updated.

Parents and carers also reported some really great things happening in our area from great school staff and support, to professional services providing a consistent approach which has had a positive impact on their child and the wider family.

One of the key areas of priority for us, which was also highlighted in the survey, was our offer for working parents. We know this is an area we need to look at, but equally as volunteers we sometimes struggle with our own caring commitments to make this happen.

However, moving forward this is something we would like to address and we want to ask parents and carers would you prefer a teams or in person event and what day or time would this be better for you?

We will add a Facebook post onto our group and page and also email members to gather this feedback.

Thank you again for your support and feedback, it really does help us make our service the best it can be for our parents and carers.

Your Family Support Team can support in various different ways including developing routines, visuals, social stories,, understanding communicative behaviour, sensory strategies and regulation. We can also signpost and refer to other services that could support you.

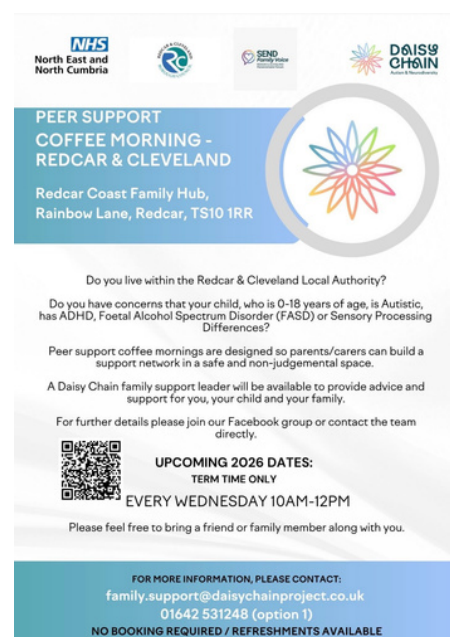
Bespoke visuals include visual timetables, now and next' boards, and social stories. These can help children and young people to feel more confident about what is happening and when it's happening throughout the day, and in turn support them to feel less worried. The visuals can support transitions from one activity to the next and increase understanding and processing of situations, events and changes to normal routines.

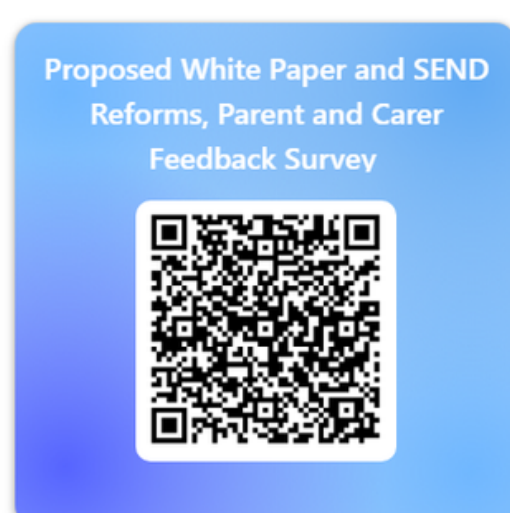


The White Paper and SEND Reforms Survey

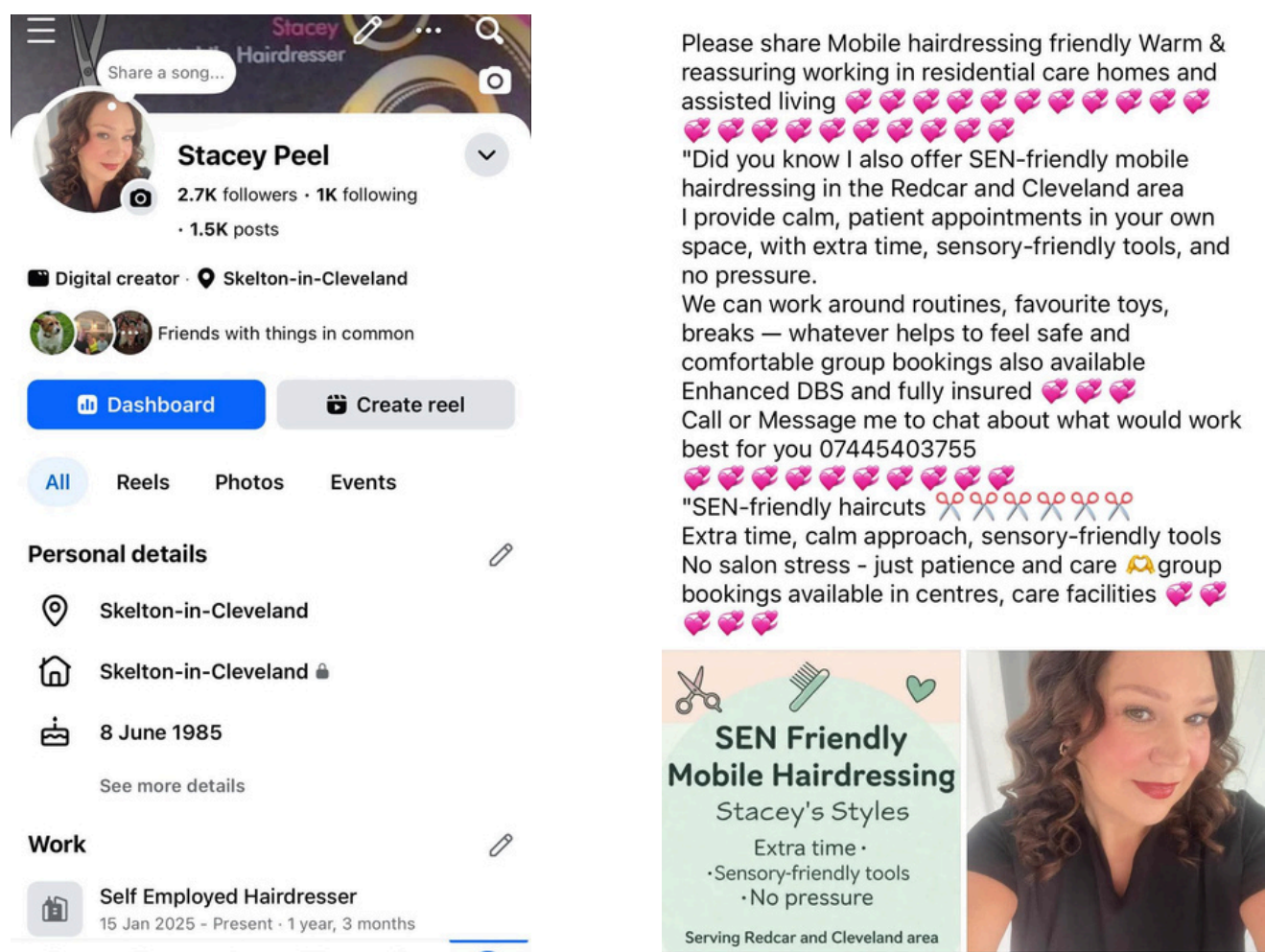
We are liaising with Rachael, who will be at our next White Paper Event, for her to come and meet families.

Our goal is to give parents the tools they need to advocate for their child, including how to prepare for GP appointments when requesting Right to Choose.

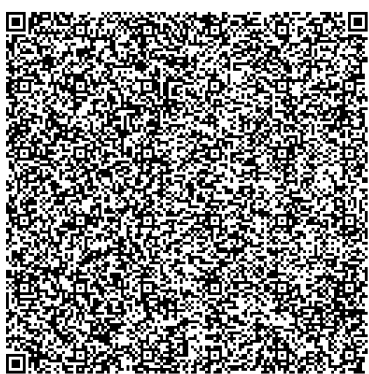
If you are considering an NHS autism assessment for your child, Paloma Health we're sharing a free, 45-minute webinar to help you find the right path.

The Early Years Area SENDCo coordinates the support provided by the Early Years SEND Practitioners, who were previously known as and sometimes still referred to as Portage. The team support children who have a significant delay in two or more areas of their development, from birth to school age. Redcar and Cleveland SEN department

The SEND Team is responsible for Education, Health, and Care Needs Assessments (working in collaboration with the family, child or young person and professionals). They also manage the placement and provision for children with Education, Health, Care Plan (EHCP) as well as annual reviews. The SEND team consists of a Statutory SEND Manager, SEND Lead Officers, PFA Coordinator, SEND Officers, Independent Travel Trainers, SEND Business and Data Officer and the SEND administration team.
